



Course: 1100 Wireless Field Training (*Must have attended *Panel training*)

Intended Audience: Installation Technicians, Service Technicians and Programmers

Purpose: Provide attendees with an overview and introduction to DMP's wireless technology; introduce the equipment, demonstrate the proper installation and programming methods.

Course Objectives: After completing this course, attendees will be able to:

- Understand the basics of 900 mhz technology
- Understand the proper way to install DMP 1100 wireless
- Understand the correct way to program a DMP 1100 wireless
- Pass the necessary exams required for DMP 1100 Series wireless certification

Course Time and Delivery: This course consists of a total of eight (8) hours of interactive classroom training, combining traditional classroom style teaching with hands on training.

Training Materials and Equipment (provided by Dealer):

- One (1) working *panel, 1100 Receiver, 1101/1102 transmitter, 1118 indicator light, 1142, 1145, 1146 or 1147 fob and keypad per every three (3) attendees
- Meeting room set up classroom style (Table and three (3) chairs with power at each table)

* Panel choice is up to Dealer, based on which panel will be utilized the most. 1100 Receiver must accompany panel (1100D = XT30/XT50, 1100X = XR100/XR500)
