Feature


The following feature only displays when the App User has been given Administration Authority Level by the dealer on the Vk.securecomwireless.com Dealer Admin site. Please see the Technical Update for Vk.securecomwireless.com (TU-0818) for more information on Authority Level options.

This feature is compatible with the following systems:

- XT30/XT50/XTL Series control panels operating with Version 117 or higher firmware
- XR150/XR350/XR550 series control panels operating with Version 103 or higher firmware
- CellComSL communicator
- iComSL communicator

Multi-System Administration

The MyVirtualKeypad.com™ Browser now provides an Administration login to allow multi-system changes for App Users, Groups, Users, Schedules and Reports without having to go into each system individually. Systems can be organized into groups for quick updating. The Administration login has the following tab options available:



App Users

The App Users tab displays a list of app users for all the systems linked to the current App User logged in. Each App User can use their email address to log into MyVirtualKeypad.com or the Virtual Keypad apps.

Groups

The Groups tab displays the customer's groups and systems. Creating groups organizes the customer's systems into districts or regions for easier report creation. When adding a Schedule or User Code to multiple systems simultaneously, the information is sent to all systems selected without having to connect to each system individually.

Users

The Users tab displays the user names and email addresses of the selected system for adding, editing or deleting from all or any of the customer's systems.

Schedules

The Schedules tab displays the systems of the selected system for adding, editing or deleting from all or any of the customer's systems.

Reports

Quick Reports

A single system is selected from a list for a report containing a specific type of event. Choose from the following list to generate the report:

- Today's System Events
- All Troubles and Alarms
- All Systems Users
- Arming/Disarming Exceptions

Custom Reports

Single or multiple system(s) selected and used to generate useful reports containing all events or a single event for a specific or general date range.
