### Version 1.5.5 Update

Effective July 10, 2017, the Dealer Admin Site (dealeradmin.securecomwireless.com) is updated to Version 1.5.5 (7/10/17). As of Version 1.5.5 (7/10/17), the following features are now available.

### Features

The following features are available for panels with Version 171 firmware or higher.

#### Technician User Profile

When you add or edit a profile, there is now a check box that allows you to enable the Technician User profile option. This feature is available for XR150/XR550 Series panels.

## Sunrise/Sunset Schedules

Sunrise/Sunset schedules use the panel's weather zip code to stay synced with sunrise and sunset times throughout the year. You can now program these schedules through Dealer Admin by navigating to the Favorite, Output, or Time Schedule page. This feature is available for XT30/XT50, XTLplus, and XR150/XR550 Series panels.




Figure 2: Adding a Sunrise/Sunset Schedule

## Output Arming Types

Outputs can now be assigned to arming types. When assigning an output to an arming type in panel programming, only the appropriate options for the arming type will display. This feature is available for XT30/XT50 and XTLplus Series panels only.

## Output Schedules

Output schedules are now supported for outputs 51-54 and 61-64 on XTLplus Series panels. One schedule is available for each output.

## Send User Codes to Z-Wave Locks

Now, there is a check box on the **System User Codes** page that allows you to select which user codes are sent to Z-Wave locks. This box appears when a system has had Z-Wave locks enabled through the Dealer Admin Site. Checking the box sends the selected user code to the lock, unchecking the box removes the user code from the lock. User codes 2 through 20 can be sent. This feature is available on XT30/XT50 and XTLplus Series panels only.
