Features

New Tech App Default Programming Settings

With Version 1.5.0 (11/15/16) of the Dealer Admin Site, you can create defaults to send to XTLPplus panels that have a cellular connection type. Default programming can then be sent to those panels using the Tech App. To access this setting, navigate to the Dealer Admin Site, click on **Tools** in the side menu, and then select **Default Programming**. Under the **Default Programming** tab, select the **Panel** and **Connection Type**. Then click **Add New**. See Figure 1.

Favorites and Z-Wave Device Lists

Now, dealers can view a list of their customer's programmed **Favorites** and **Z-Wave Devices** through the Dealer Admin Site. This feature displays the **Number**, **Name**, and **Type** associated with a favorite or Z-Wave device. To view these lists, navigate to a panel's **System Information** page and then select **Automation** from the side menu. See Figure 2. To refresh the list, click **Refresh** in the upper right corner. This feature is only available for XT30/XT50 and XTLPplus Series panels.
