Authority Level:

Standard (default) - Enable Reports is available for each system check marked in the System Access column.

Administrator - In addition to the Enable Reports column, Users and Schedules columns are available for each system check marked in the System Access column.

Columns

<u>System Access</u> - When checked, the User is linked to the system(s).

<u>Enable Reports</u> - When checked, both Standard and Administrator Authority level App users can create reports from MyVirtualKeypad.com website.



XTLC/XTLN Panel Programming

A new programming option has been added to the Side Navigation Menu to allow programming using essential programming options for the XTLC/XTLN Version 123 (8/27/15) firmware. When the panel programming defaults are acceptable for installation and only basic programming options are needed. Programming allows the installer to quickly enter information without navigating all of the programming menus.
