SCS-VR for 500 accounts is now being manufactured as Version 1.3.6 (9/24/14) and contains the following features.

256-bit Encryption

SCS-VR now supports 256-bit AES encryption. Before SCS-VR can accept 256-bit encrypted messages, the following steps must be performed to properly configure Java on the SCS-VR computer.

- Download the Java Cryptography Extension (JCE) Unlimited Strength Jurisdiction Policy Files compatible with your version of Java.
 - a. The files for JRE8 can be found at <u>http://www.oracle.com/technetwork/java/javase/</u> <u>downloads/jce8-download-2133166.html</u>
 - Before downloading the files, agree to the Oracle Binary Code License Agreement for the Java SE Platform Products, which covers exporting any product that supports greater than 128- bit encryption
- Extract the policy files to the appropriate folder in the Java directory. Typically this is located at: Program Files/Java/jre8/lib/security.
