1100 Series Wireless Enhancements

Two new remote programming options have been added to support operation of new DMP control panel wireless features. The new options improve 1100 Series Wireless operation in two ways:

- Selectable suppression of non-urgent wireless buzzers can be programmed. You can select full suppression, suppression during sleeping hours, or no suppression.
- Longer transmitter supervision time is available to minimize false missing messages

Version 1.38 Software Update

Effective October 2007, all Remote Link and System Link software are being manufactured as Version 1.38 (9/27/07) software. This version is an update from the 1.37 (8/22/07) software previously shipped and contains new features.

Transmitter Supervision Time

A new selection of 240 minutes has been added to the 1100 Series transmitter Zone, Key Fob and Output Supervision Time options. The 15 minute supervision time option has been removed. This is available for the XRSuper6, XR20, and XR40 Command Processor™ Panels Version 305 using the 1100D Wireless Receiver Version 105 or with the XR100 or XR500 Series Command Processor™ Panels Version 120 using the 1100X Wireless Receiver Version 105.

Wireless Audible Annunciation

XRSuper6, XR20 and XR40 Command Processor Panels

Remote Link now provides a new Wireless Audible Annunciation option in System Options available for the XRSuper6, XR20, and XR40 Command Processor™ Panels Version 305 using the 1100D Wireless Receiver Version 105.

Wireless Audible Annunciation: This option displays when the House Code entered is for a DMP 1100 Series Wireless system (1-50). Select the keypad buzzer annunciation method for wireless troubles. Select ANY to enable annunciation anytime. Select DAY to enable annunciation except during sleeping hours (9 PM to 9 AM). Select MIN (minimum) to annunciate only Fire and Fire Verify zones during daytime hours (9 AM to 9 PM). Default is DAY.
