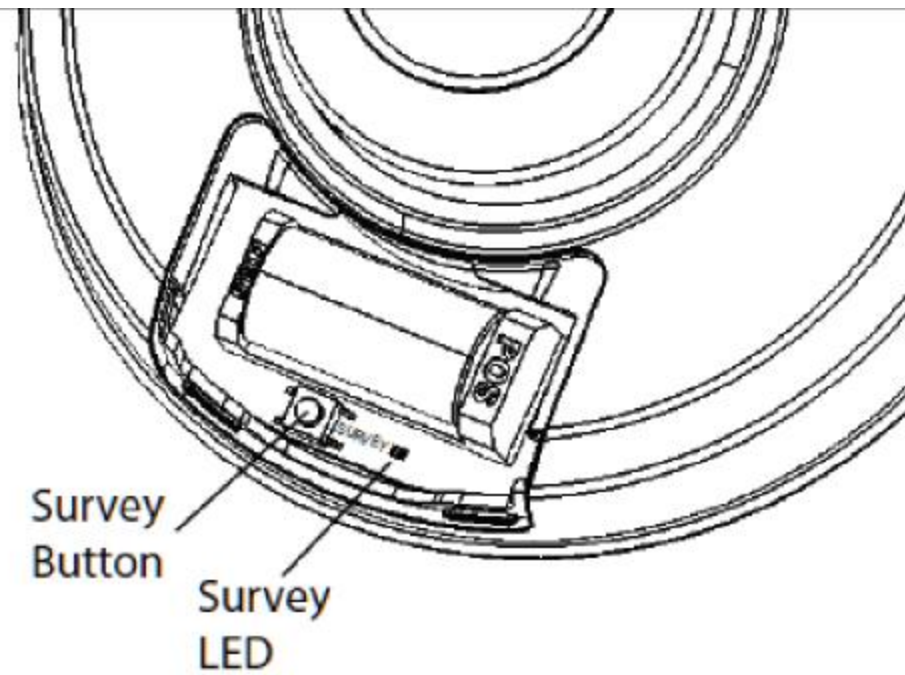

Test Points

Testing the Detector
Carefully short the two terminals (screw heads)
momentarily to send an alarm signal to the control panel.



Test the communication between the control panel
and the detector
before permanently mounting the detector as
follows:
1. Program the transmitter into the panel. See
Programming
Transmitter in the Panel. Install the battery.
Note: Survey operation requires that the detector
have the mounting
base installed to engage the tamper switch.
2. Hold the detector up in the location where you
plan to install it.
3. Press the survey button (See Figure 2) to send
data to the receiver
to confirm operation.
