# **Version 171 Firmware Update**

Version 171 (7/14/17) firmware is now available for download on the DMP Dealer Direct Website at http://dmp.com/dealer.

XT Series control panels will be manufactured with updated Version 171 (7/14/17) firmware on the following dates:

• XTLplus: July 24, 2017

XT30/XT50: August 14, 2017

All inventory will be updated by September 22, 2017.

## **Features**

## **Sunrise/Sunset Schedules**

Sunrise/Sunset schedules use local weather information to stay synced with sunrise and sunset times throughout the year. You can set the schedule to activate or deactivate 5, 10, 15, 30, 45, or 60 minutes before or after sunrise or sunset. Sunrise/Sunset schedules can be applied to Favorites or Outputs on XT30/XT50 and XTLplus Series panels.

Note: A weather zip code must be entered in SYSTEM OPTIONS for this option to be available.

#### Add or Remove Multiple Z-Wave Devices

It is now easier to add and remove multiple Z-Wave devices. During the add or remove process, the keypad displays PRESS BUTTON ON DEVICE TO ADD or PRESS BUTTON ON DEVICE TO REMOVE after the previous device has finished processing. This display signals you to continue to the next device.

**Note:** If you are adding multiple devices, be sure to take note of the order in which the devices are added. You will name the devices in that same order.

#### **Output Arming Types**

Outputs can now be assigned to arming types. When assigning an output to an arming type in panel programming, the keypad displays HOME and AWAY for Home/Away systems. If a Bedroom area is programmed into the panel, the SLEEP screen also displays. For All/Perimeter systems, the ALL and PERIM screens appear. For Area systems, you will see the ARM OUT screen.

#### **Z-Wave Back-Up and Restore**

Remote Link™ now stores a copy of all Z-Wave programming in case there is a data loss at the panel or an associated 738Zplus Z-Wave Interface Module. This allows programming to be sent back to the panel or the 738Zplus if either is damaged.

## **Z-Wave Thermostat Battery Status**

When a battery-operated thermostat has a low battery, a notification appears on the keypad and a push notification is received through the Virtual Keypad App. These notifications alert end users that the battery will need to be changed soon.

## **User Codes in Z-Wave Locks**

With Version 171 (7/14/17), you can now use the Virtual Keypad<sup> $\mathrm{IM}$ </sup> App to send user codes to Z-Wave locks.

## **Output Schedules** (XTLplus Series panels only)

Output schedules are now available for outputs 51-54 and 61-64. One schedule is available for each output.

- 3. Click on the Remote Update feature located in the side menu.
- 4. Click **Update System**. The **Update System** page displays the panel's current firmware version and whether or not an update is available.

Note: A \$10.00 service charge will be applied if the panel uses a cellular comminucation type.

From the **Update System** page, you can also access a PDF of the new firmware version's technical update that outlines the included features and updated functionality.

To view the firmware update status of all of your customers' panels, click on **Tools** in the side menu and select the **Remote Update Dashboard**.
