

SCS-VR 2500/5000/10000/20000 Accounts October 2014

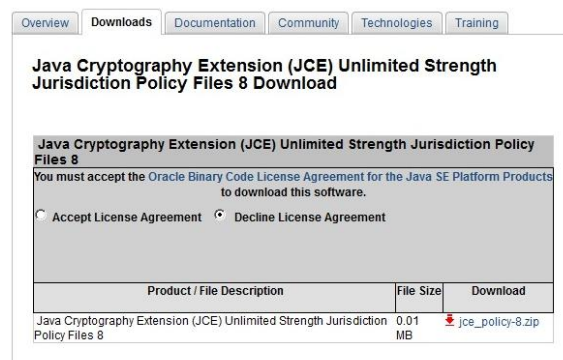
Version 1.3.5 Software Update

SCS-VR for 2500, 5000, 10000 and 20000 accounts is now being manufactured as Version 1.3.5 (9/26/14) and contains the following features.

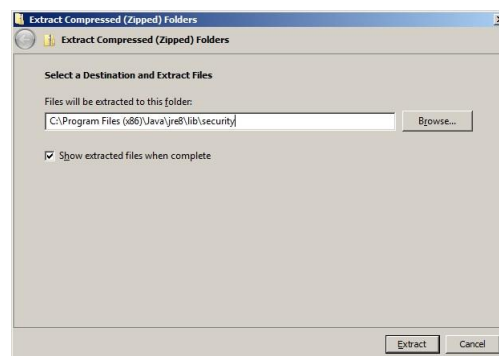
256-bit Encryption

SCS-VR now supports 256-bit AES encryption. Before SCS-VR can accept 256-bit encrypted messages, the following steps must be performed to properly configure Java on the SCS-VR computer.

- 1) Download the **Java Cryptography Extension (JCE) Unlimited Strength Jurisdiction Policy Files** compatible with your version of Java.
 - a. The files for JRE8 can be found at <http://www.oracle.com/technetwork/java/javase/downloads/jce8-download-2133166.html>
 - b. Before downloading the files, agree to the Oracle Binary Code License Agreement for the Java SE Platform Products, which covers exporting any product that supports greater than 128-bit encryption



- 2) Extract the policy files to the appropriate folder in the Java directory. Typically this is located at: Program Files/Java/jre8/lib/security.



- 3) Update SCS-VR using the SCS-VR installer.
