

## 1145 Series Wireless Key Fob September 2014

### Version 107 Software Update

Effective September 2, 2014, all 1145 Series Wireless Key Fobs are being manufactured with Version 107 (6/13/13) software.

### Updated Operation

#### Stored Message

1145 Series Wireless Key Fobs, on rare occasions, may have sent a button press when no button was being pressed. This could occur if a button had been pressed just as the key fob was returning to the range of the wireless receiver. The button press may have been incorrectly stored by the key fob to be sent with the next communication to the wireless receiver such as a battery test.

### Obtaining the New Software

To update, return any older 1145 Series Wireless Key Fob to DMP and simply indicate "Update to Latest Version 107 Software" on the 6-digit Repair Authorization tag. The update will be done as a Warranty Repair at no charge, regardless of when the key fob was purchased. If you need Repair Authorization tags contact DMP Customer Service at 1-800-641-4282.

#### Software Version

The software version of an 1145 is found by removing the back cover of the key fob.
