Schedules

The Virtual Keypad Browser now allows the user to view, add, edit and delete panel schedules for Arming/Disarming, Favorites, Outputs, and Doors.

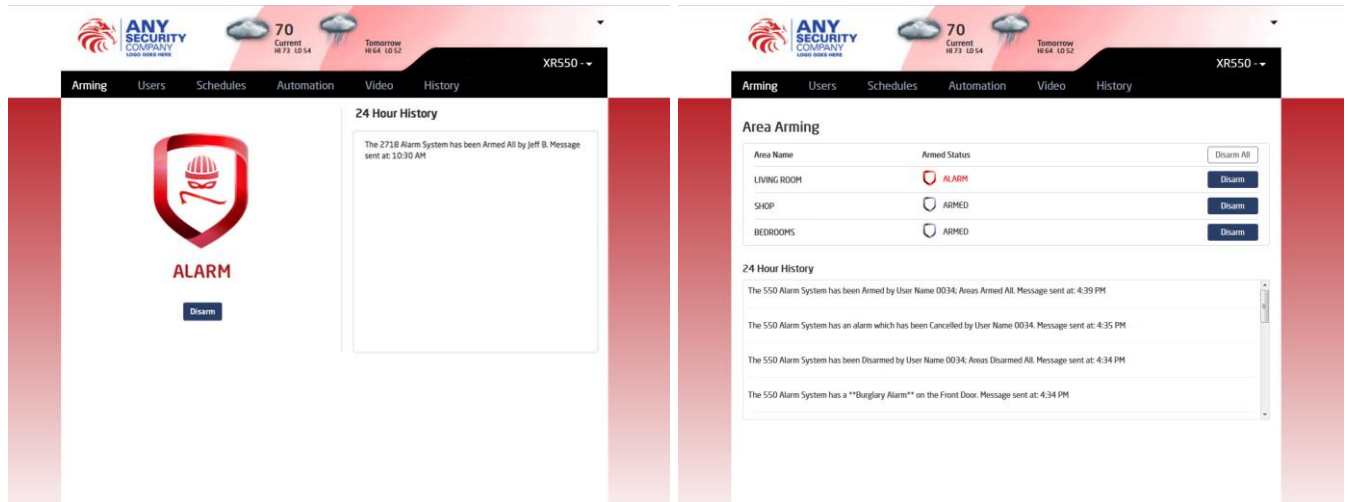
Door Control and Lockdown

The Virtual Keypad Browser now allows users of XR150/XR350/XR550 control panels to lock and unlock Door type devices from the Automation Tab. A Lockdown button is also provided to lock all public doors in the system.
