Version 111 Software Update

Version 111 (5/2/12) software is now available for download on the DMP Dealer Direct Website at <http://dmp.com/dealer>.

Effective May 21, 2012, all XT30/XT50 Series and XTL panels are being manufactured with Version 111 (5/2/12) software. This version contains the following updated operation and features.

Features

False Alarm Question

The USE FALSE ALARM QUESTION? option in System Options now defaults to YES instead of NO.

USE FALSE ALARM QUESTION? NO YES
--

Use False Alarm Question

Select YES to display IS THIS A FALSE ALARM? NO YES at the keypad in place of CANCEL VERIFY when a burglar alarm occurs. Select NO to display CANCEL VERIFY.

This operates for ALL/PERIM and HOME/SLEEP/ AWAY arming systems. Default is YES.

Remote Disarm

The REMOTE DISARM option in Remote Options that allows the panel to be disarmed remotely now defaults to YES instead of NO. This is to allow MyAccess™ or the Virtual Keypad App to remotely disarm the system.

DISARM NO YES

Remote Disarm

Enter YES to enable the panel to be disarmed remotely. Selecting NO disables remote disarming. Default is YES.

Updated Operation

Time update processing

XT Series panels now correctly process time updates from the Central Station receiver.

Previously, XT Series panels with Version 108 (6/27/11) and higher software failed to process a time update from the Central Station receiver if a remote connection from Remote Link or the Virtual Keypad App had been initiated since the previous time update occurred.

As of July 9, 2012, inventory for the XT30/XT50 Series and XTL panels will be completely updated to Version 111 (5/2/12) software.
