

## **Secondary Power Supply**

1.5 Amps maximum charge current. Use only 12 VDC batteries. Replace every 3-5 years. Refer to LT-0453 for installation details.

#### **Power Limited**

All circuits in the Model 505 comply with the requirements for inherent power limitation and are Class 2 with exception of the red battery wire.
